### Subjects discussed:

#### 1. Supplemental Rules

These were discussed and modified to the current Local and USGA changes and will be placed in the Library (in Golf Fusion) by May 1.

#### 2. Plaques need updating.

The plaques for the Major Championships will be updated by Dean Galiano and re-hung in the clubhouse.

#### 3. Bulletin Board

This is located to the left of the entry to the clubhouse off the back patio. It is never noticed because of its location and hasn't been updated recently because of that. Seamandel and Zimmermann will review the areas where it might be better located.

#### 4. 4<sup>th</sup> Of July Event

An event was discussed for 4<sup>th</sup> Of July (a Thursday) and James Wooley has volunteered to run a Scramble. The Men's Club will participate in this event instead of trying to run a separate weekly event.

#### 5. 50/50 Dinner For May

It was determined to have a buffet dinner (free to all Members and Summer Members) on Wednesday, May 22. Happy Hour from 5:30 – 6:00 pm and dinner at 6:00. Guests will be charged \$25 (cost per person of the buffet) and the club will absorb the taxes and tip for the guests. More on this from President Seamandel in the future.

#### 6. Un-marked Ground-Under-Repair On Greens

A few greens have damage (particularly #3) and there is some confusion about it being Ground-Under-Repair, and therefore allowing relief from the area or line-of-sight to the pin. Seamandel and Zimmermann to review the affected greens and determine those that may apply to the GUR Rule.

#### 7. Women Playing In Summer
