Subjects discussed:

- 1. Hole-In-1 Fund for Non-sanctioned Games (with mainly league players).
 - When there is a game within 30 or so minutes, that's the only game in town for the Hole-In-1 eligibility.
 - When there is an Away Game outside 30 minutes or so distance, a club member may run a game at PMGR, but it will be advertised only after the Away Game is full. Any Hole-In-1 made at this PMGR game will receive \$100 for a Hole-In-1 if they are in the pot.
 - At year-end, all money in the Hole-In-1 pot will be rolled into a new Hole-In-1 pot starting that new year. Everyone will have to pay \$5 to get into that new pot, and the pay-out for the first pot of the year will include the left-over pot from the previous year plus the new pot. Big money, folks, but you'll have to get into the new pot.
- **2. Away Games for 2020**? No plans because of the virus. This will be flexible, and any Away Game is likely to be local.
- 3. Women's Flight On Special Days? This is unlikely, but may happen a couple of times if there are at least 8 ladies to make a flight, but this is for scrip money only. All players will participate together in the Side Games (Skins and Proxies).
- **4. Players Riding Together.** Players from the same household may request to play in the same cart on a regular basis. The club has tried to accommodate letting players ride in a cart alone, which works if they have no large number of players needing carts after we tee off.
