Subjects discussed:

1. **Election** – The election for Club President and Vice President will be held on Saturday Apr 30, after that day's round. Lunch will also be provided on that day. A separate e-mail will be sent out asking for nominations.
2. **Ideas to Increase Member Involvement:** Increased member involvement in the pre and post round set-up and score keeping is always appreciated and encouraged.
 - a. The Tournament Chair - Dean Galiano – will be coordinating this effort. Please talk to Dean if you would like to help with Check-In, Proxies, Scorecards, Scoring, etc.
 - b. It was agreed that each week's Free Play winner will be asked to assist with that day's Check-In process.
3. **Lunches:**
 - a. The Club will continue to sponsor post-round lunches twice each month.
 - b. The lunch schedule for the next three months will be:
 - April: Thursday April 14 and Saturday April 30
 - May: Saturday May 14 and Thursday May 26
 - June: Saturday June 11 and Thursday June 23.
4. **Summer Membership** – It was agreed that the Club would offer a special Co-Ed Summer Membership again this year. The price for the Summer Membership will be \$35 and will extend from May 1 until October 1, 2022. Applications will be available in the Painted Mountain Pro Shop.
5. **Adding Handicap Limit to Club By-Laws** – There was discussion about adding a handicap limit to the Club By-Laws – setting a maximum handicap. This was decided against. There will be no changes to the By-Laws regarding handicaps.
6. **Gross Skins Discussion** – The Club continues to evaluate data to ensure that the Side Games remain competitive to all golfers. Dean Galiano has been collecting data showing the winners of the

various games – Gross and Net Skins and KP/Proxies. The data continues to show that the overall mix of games remains competitive to both Low and High handicaps.
